

INVESTIGATION POSTER

Your assignment is to do an Investigation about a subject that interests you. You are to choose a person, place, or thing and create an Investigation Poster. This investigation will be done on a 11 inch by 17 inch piece of construction paper. You will use what you have learned about your chosen subject to make an attractive display that highlights the important things you have learned about the subject. This report should include some artwork that depicts your subject. The artwork can be something you have drawn or created, or it can be photos or copies of artwork that depicts your subject.

Your Investigation Poster should include the following:

1. A title.
2. A minimum of three graphic items. One of these must be a diagram or a drawing. The others may be pictures, photos, graphs, postcards, any graphic item that correlates with your subject.
3. A border related to the topic. The border should be a minimum of one inch wide and no greater than one and one-half inch wide.
4. A minimum of three paragraphs with correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation. These paragraphs should have a topic sentence, sentences that give details about the topic, and a concluding sentence.

5. A minimum of 6 text features. The paragraphs count as three. The other three could be a caption under a picture or a list of interesting or unusual facts.

You will make a rough sketch of what you would like your investigation look like.

You will write a rough draft of your paragraphs.

You will type or use your best cursive or printing. Final draft must be typed or in ink.

You will not leave any area of your poster blank. It should have some type of background coloring where there is no text, diagrams, or pictures.
