## Inventor / Scientist Report

Read carefully before starting.

### Overview:

You will be researching and writing a report on a famous inventor or scientist as part of your Variables science unit. Choose an inventor/ scientist you find interesting and check out a library book on this person. You will need to do research. You will also need to construct a “prop” to go along with your report. The prop can be your inventor’s most famous invention, or an example of what your scientist worked with in his/her experiments. Example: You might include a model of an old fashioned telephone to go along with your report on Alexander Gram Bell.

### Requirements:

1. Report:
  - a. 1 page or longer
  - b. Tell about your inventor/scientist – Who, What, When, Where?
  - c. How did the inventor/scientist change history?
  - d. Tell about your inventor’s inventions or scientist’s experiments (discoveries).
  - e. Typed or neatly written.
  - f. Include an introductory paragraph (introduce person) and a concluding paragraph that tells how your inventor/scientist influenced life today. For the introduction, use a creative “hook” to get readers attention.
2. Model:
  - a. Realistic looking model of your scientists/inventors most famous discovery or invention.
  - b. Short label telling the significance of your model.
